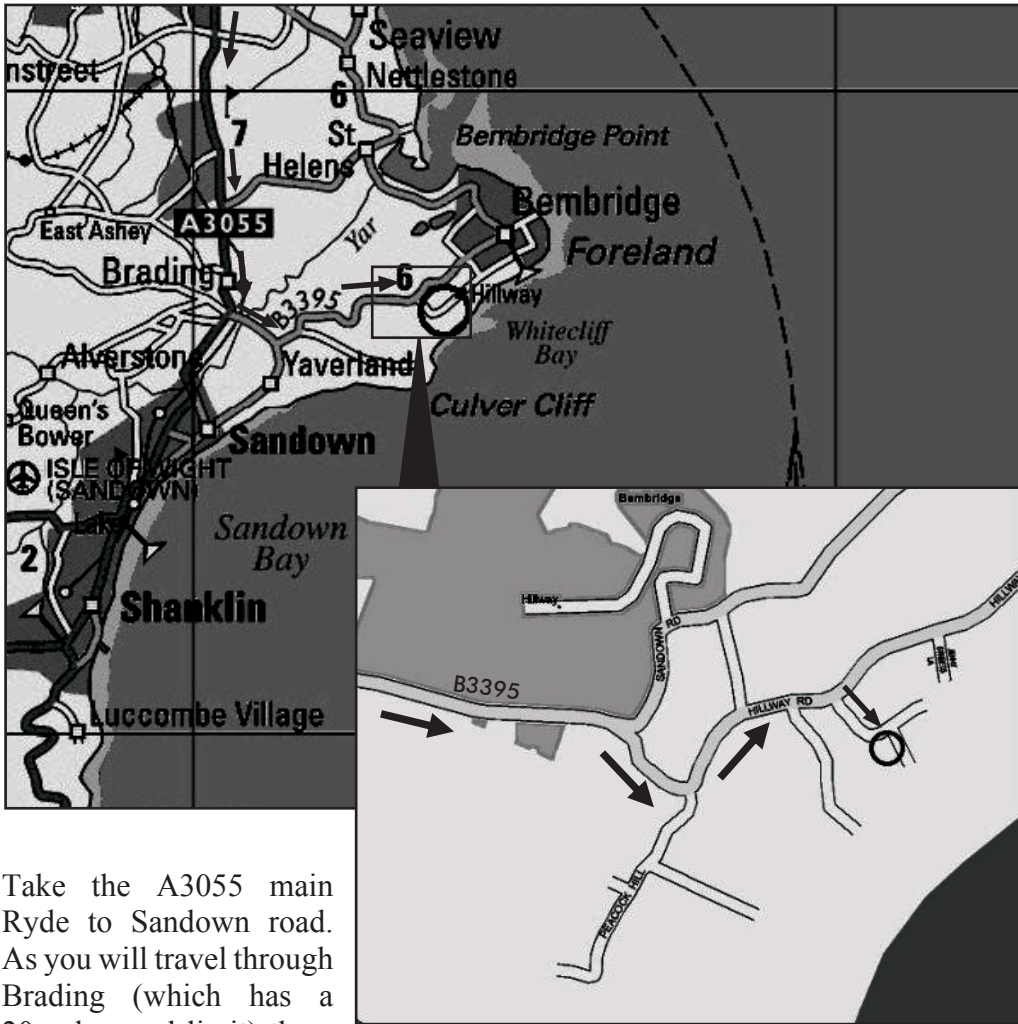


HOW TO FIND US



Take the A3055 main Ryde to Sandown road. As you will travel through Brading (which has a 20mph speed limit) there is a sharp left hand bend and then, just outside the 20mph limit, a sharp right hand bend. Continue along the road until you come to a set of traffic lights. Turn left at these lights and continue down the B3395 until you come to a mini roundabout. Straight on (first exit) at the mini roundabout and continue on the B3395 for approx another mile and a quarter. Then bear right for approx 300 yards then bear left onto Hillway road. Whitecliff Bay is approx. 500 yards along on the right.

- 1 Show will be run in accordance with FBAS show rules.
- 2 Gravel is **NOT** allowed except in class Z.
- 3 All pre-booked entries (before 10.30am on Sat. 19 June) are 30p (10 or more entries £3.00). Entries received after this or on the day of the show are 50p each irrespective of numbers.
- 4 All breeders classes to consist of **FOUR** fish no more than 14 months old on the day of the show.
- 5 The organisers will not be held responsible for any problems, loss or damage to any exhibit for whatever cause.
- 6 Water - Use of local water is entirely at the risk of the exhibitor and water quality is the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is strongly advised that exhibitors bring sufficient mature water with them.
- 7 De-benching will not be permitted until after presentation of awards.
- 8 Benching from 09:00 until 11:45 on Sunday 20 June. Judging will commence at 12:00 prompt.
- 9 It is assumed by the organisers that owners of entries requiring a DEFRA licence hold such a licence.
