## SHOW RULES

- 1) The show will be run in accordance with FBAS Show Rules.
- 2) Exhibitors are to supply their own tanks; SLADAS will supply tanks for Class (Z).
- 3) No gravel allowed in Classes B to X.
- 4) Entries in Breeders' Classes will comprise 4 fish not older than 14 months on the day of the show (Not before 01/03/09) and must have been bred by the Exhibitor.  
The date of birth must be stated on the entry form.
- 5) Top lighting will be supplied for Class Ag.
- 6) Photography, filming and video taping will only be permitted after judging with the permission of the Show Manager.
- 7) Whilst every care will be taken SLADAS cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage, however caused.
- 8) The Show Hall will be open to exhibitors and the public on completion of judging, approximately 3pm. Other attractions are open all day. Prize giving will be at approximately 5.30pm.
- 9) Debenching will take place prior to prize giving, when announced by the Show Organisers. No debenching to take place prior to this without permission from the Show organisers, and with a Steward in attendance.
- 10) No animals, other than exhibits and Guide dogs, allowed in the show hall.
- 11) **“Suitability of water”** It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that the water, in which their exhibits are shown, is suitable for that exhibit. The organizers will not be responsible for any loss of, or adverse effect on, any exhibit caused by the quality or composition of the local or introduced water supply, which may contain chemicals or differ in quality to that which the exhibit is normally accustomed.

ALL late entries will be paid for at a cost of 40p, none accepted after 11.15 am on the day of the Show. Judging starts at 12 noon.
