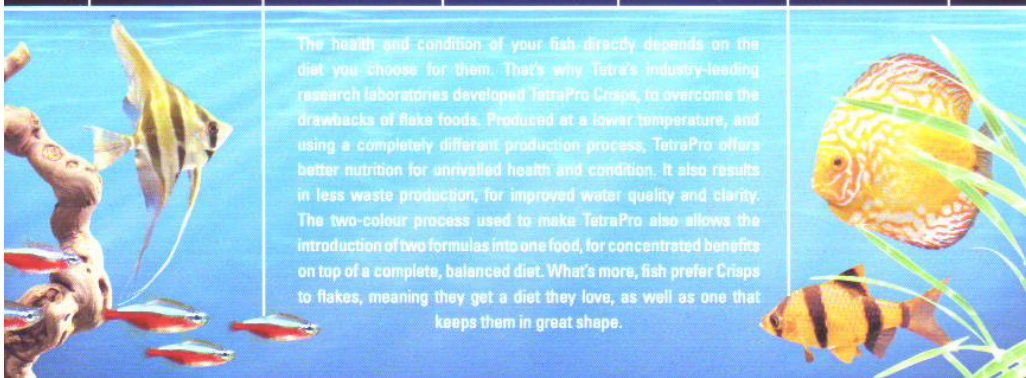

Entry fees: 20p per entry by post, fax or e-mail.

Closing date for post, fax or e-mail Entries: Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> September 2012

Phone entries 20p up to 9 p.m. on Friday 14<sup>th</sup> September.

Late entries up to 11.00 a.m. on the day of the Show, at the Show Manager's discretion, at a fee of 25p. Every 6<sup>th</sup> entry free (excluding phone entries and entries on the day).

**Breeders Classes** must be teams of four fish not more than fourteen months old on the day of the Show. **Date of birth must be shown on the entry forms**, and the fish must have been bred by the exhibitor.

**Benching from 9.30 a.m. and must be fully benched by 12 noon**

**Judging commences at 12.30 pm.** Prize-giving between 16.30 & 17.30.

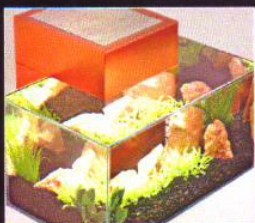

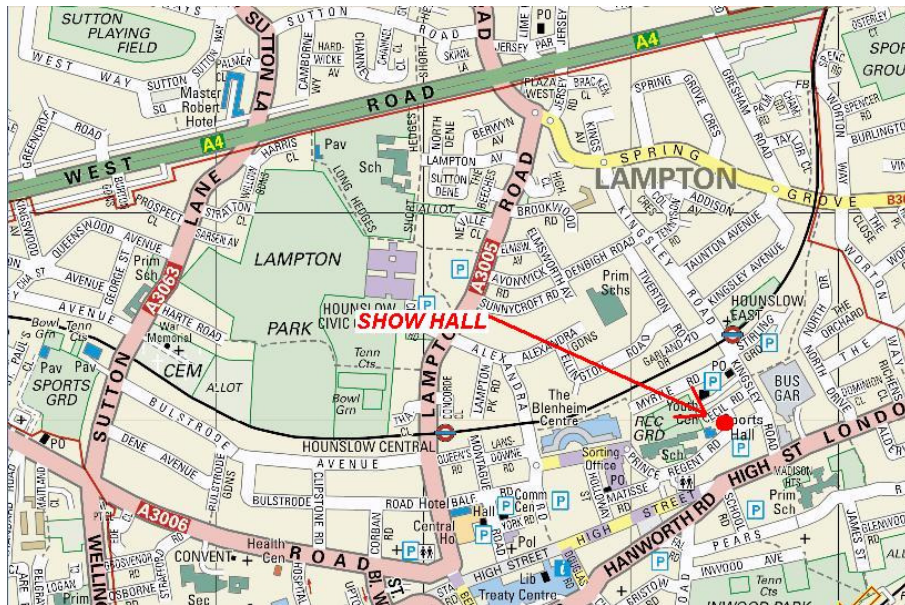
