

Directions to venue.

From South Shields/Jarrow/Hebburn areas

(1) Head along the A194 to the Whitemare Pool roundabout and turn right onto the A184, (2) stay on this road and travel through Gateshead town centre, passed the Civic Centre on your left hand side. Next head down Bensham Road B1426 (Bensham Bank) until you come to the 2nd set of traffic lights. On your right you will see a residential home. Turn right at these lights onto Cuthbert Street, next take your 1st left onto School Street, follow this road that leads onto Derwentwater Road. Approximately ¼ of a mile down the road on the left hand side is the venue.

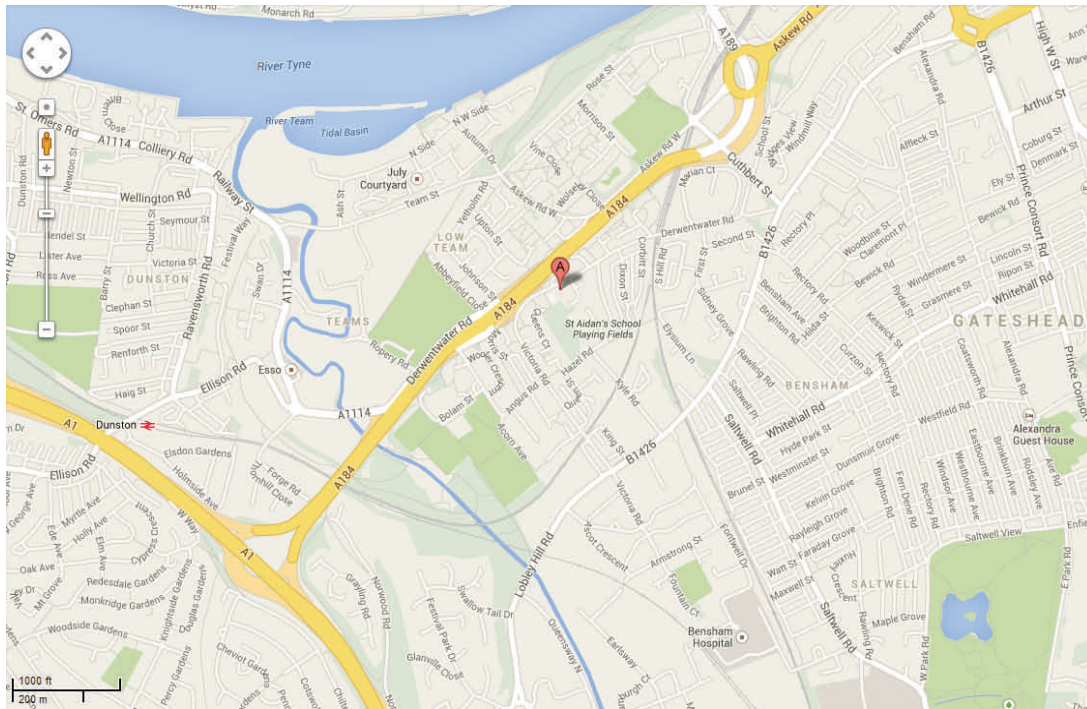
From Sunderland/Washington areas

Head along the A194 to the Whitemare Pool roundabout and turn left onto the A184, Now follow instruction (2) form above directions.

Head for Newcastle/Gateshead along the A1. Take the exit for the A184 turn right onto Cuthbert Street and approx 100 yards up the road, turn right onto Derwentwater Road. Follow Derwentwater Road for approx ¼ mile to the venue on the left hand side.

I would like to welcome you to the 1st North East Aquatic Community (NEAC) Open Show in Gateshead, Tyne & Wear.

First let me tell you a little about our newly formed society. The North East Aquatic Community started life in 2010 as an online forum for fishkeepers in the North East. Since then we had a few get-togethers at members homes, to visit their fish houses etc. In 2012 the members started talking about the possibility of having an auction to help pay for forum expenses and to provide prizes for the competitions we hold online. This lead us towards our 1st auction in April 2013, and on to the discussion about holding an open show in 2014, and here we are holding that show.

This show will be run to FBAS rules & standards in conjunction with our 3rd auction. We are hoping, with your support, to make this show the biggest in the North East, and one of the biggest in the country. With the backing of our sponsors & the FBAS we are sure you will have a fantastic day whether you're exhibiting fish or just checking out the auction

The Championship Classes we have been allocated this year are E Labyrinth Fish & R Xiphophorus Platties. The top 4 places in these classes will be allowed entry into the Supreme Final at the Festival of Fishkeeping, to be held on 4th October 2014 at The Houslow Urban Farm, Greater London.

To encourage younger people and new exhibitors, we will be having a Junior Class and also a Novice Class. To enter as a Junior you must be 8 to 16 years of age. In the Novice Class all we ask is that the exhibitor is above junior age and have never shown fish before, or have not shown for at least 5 years. In both classes exhibits can be any single fish from the list of classes on the centre page, with the exception of the breeders classes.

After the event we would love to hear your feedback to help us improve for future shows. 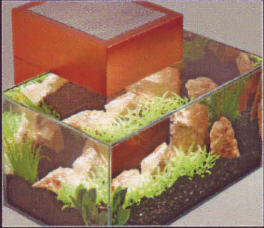
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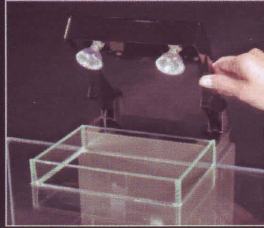

Rules on the day for show & auction.

SHOW:

Exhibit entry fee:
20p per exhibit up to a maximum of £5.
Exhibit entry fee must be paid when booking in entries.

Breeders Classes:

Teams of four fish to be no more than 14 months old on the day of the show.
Date of birth must be clearly written on a sticker.
Fish must have been bred by the exhibitor.

The Open Show will be run to FBAS Rules & Standards
A full copy of the FBAS Rules & Standards will be available in the show hall.

*Benching starts at 10am on the day of the show.
All entries must be fully benched by 12pm (noon).*

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that the water in which their exhibits are shown, is suitable for that exhibit.
The Organisers will not be held responsible for the loss of, or adverse effect upon any exhibit caused by the quality or composition of the local or introduced water supply, which may contain chemicals or differ in quality to that which the exhibit is normally accustomed.

Exhibits may not be removed from the bench before the end of the show without prior permission of the Show Secretary.
De-benching will take place after the prize giving.

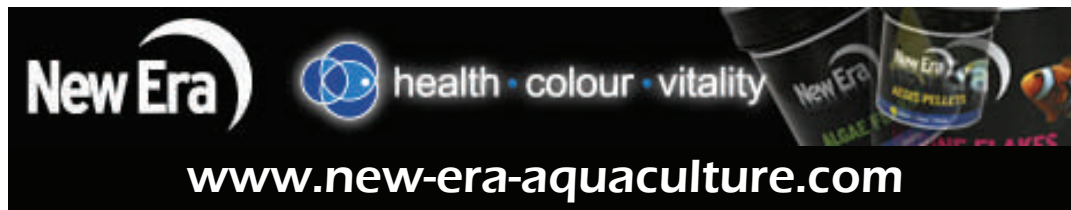
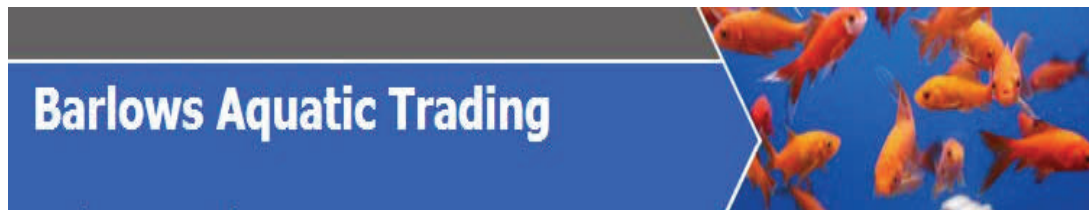
